

This great man has just one wish - that everyone would share his compassion for helping and would start practicing this win-win way of doing business.



What are Varicose Veins & Spider Veins?

Varicose veins are a direct result of abnormal blood circulation caused by a weakness in the valves which makes it a struggle for the blood to flow upward and back to your heart. With this weakness, blood flow reverses and veins become twisted and bulge. Spider veins are thin, red or blue, web-like veins that appear near the surface of the skin. Spider veins and varicose veins are pretty similar, but they each have some key

characteristics that make them distinctive from each other, mainly size.

El Paso Varicose Veins Laser Clinic

concentrates on the treatment of venous insufficiency, which is the cause of varicose veins, spider veins, leg pain, and other more severe conditions. The staff at the clinic takes pride in serving our community as effectively as possible.

Endovenous Laser Ablation treats large,

bulging varicose veins and their underlying cause, venous valve reflux. In the last few years, the use of laser treatments has become an accepted alternative for surgical stripping. With ELT, no hospital admission or surgery is required and the entire procedure can be performed in less than 45 minutes. Briefly described, endovenous laser ablation is done under local anesthesia by using ultrasound guidance to thread a small laser fiber into the diseased vein. The doctor then delivers laser energy through the fiber, which causes the vein to close as the fiber is gradually withdrawn. After the procedure, a compression hose is worn for approximately seven to ten days. Immediately after the procedure, the patient is encouraged to walk for 20 to 30 minutes and resume normal activity. You may use non-aspirin based pain medications if needed.

With **ambulatory phlebectomy**, varicose veins are removed through a series of tiny punctures using local anesthesia. This is an outpatient

procedure with minimal to no scarring. The procedure takes roughly 20 to 45 minutes and you may resume your normal activities immediately. We ask that you walk, bike, or use a treadmill for a maximum of an hour for a few days after the procedure.

During **sclerotherapy**, we inject a small volume of liquid into the diseased vein, which causes the vein to shrink, close, and gradually disappear. Sclerotherapy is used for spider veins and small varicose veins and might require multiple sessions depending on the number of diseased veins. It is performed in the doctor's office and no anesthesia is required. The procedure takes 15 to 20 minutes. After the procedure, a compression stocking should be worn for two to three days and patients should exercise for up to an hour every day for a few days after the procedure.

All of our procedures are outpatient procedures, allowing you to resume your normal daily activity immediately. There may be some minimal discomfort in the treated areas. We use state of the art technology and FDA approved solutions, ensuring your comfort and safety.

Together, they worked long hours to not only bring our customers (including many studyabroad students) home safely but to determine a course of action to ensure that customers received the best value when postponing or canceling their vacation.

The preferred relationships we have with our travel partners enable us to offer special perks to our customers - including value-added amenities, a room when a hotel is full, special pricing and discounts, etc. In the midst of this crisis, their support has expanded to include up-to-the-minute notification of itinerary changes, liberal cancelation policies, future travel credits valued at up to 225 percent of the original value and special group and travel advisor help desks to minimize hold times to allow advisors to help more customers.

Perhaps the most welcome support came in the form of protected commission on reservations that were being postponed and canceled. Many travel advisors only charge a small fee for the hours spent researching vacation options, making reservations, arranging flights, managing special room requests and dinner reservations and communicating all of this with their customers. Commission paid to an advisor by hotels, cruises and tour operators is a major part of their compensation. Without this commission protection, the work they had done for so many over the course of several months would essentially have been done for free.

If there is one thing we should all take away from 2020, it's that relationships matter. We've seen it in social media when a friend posts a need and many respond. It was apparent in the outpouring of support after the El Paso mass shooting last August. In the travel industry, relationships are what we have always touted as the main advantage of booking your travel with a travel advisor - both the personal interaction between advisor and customer and the invaluable partnership between the travel agency and our preferred travel partners. CoronaVirus has tested all of our relationships, but in our travel world, and, hopefully, in yours, it has made them that much sweeter.




